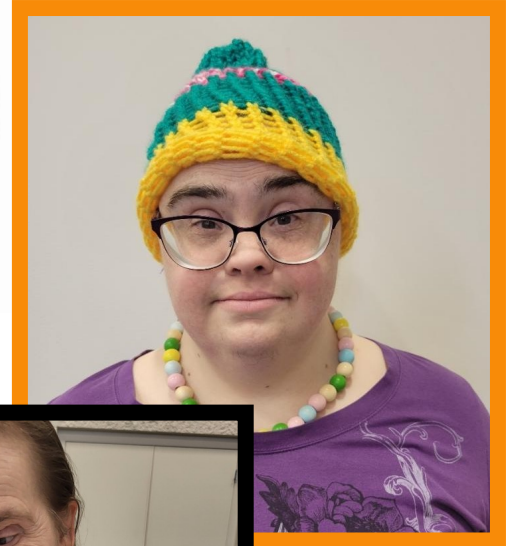

# Members Enjoy Daily Excursions!



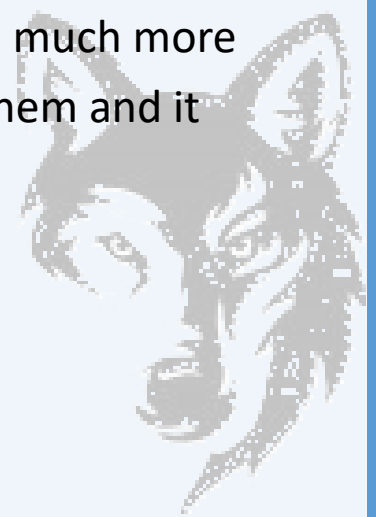
## Those with disabilities need your support on their path.
